Action Items

- 1. Inducement Resolution Amendment: CoreWeave, Inc.
 - a. S.Porath introduced the project, which involves Sales Tax Exemption in connection with \$600,000,000 cost of planned new acquisition of equipment for an AI data center.
 - b. R.J. Espina, Plant Operations Manager, CoreWeave, Inc., further discussed the request, noting that the financial incentives provided would allow them to stay competitive in a growing field, hire additional support staff, and allow for possible future expansion.
 - c. Following various questions from the Board, T. Riley moved to approve the inducement, seconded by R. Amar. The motion passed 3-0.

New Business

- 1) Termination Resolution Liptis Holdings, LLC
 - a) S. Porath explained that Liptis Holdings, who have fulfilled all of their contractual obligations to the IDA, requested a formal termination resolution to terminate their project.
 - b) R. Zodda, IDA council, explained that the project's PILOT was completed in 2021.
 - c) P. Zugibe made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by R. Amar. Motion passed 3-0.
- 2) The board reviewed the monthly labor reports.
- 3) A motion was made by the Board to enter into executive session to discuss a legal matter.
- 4) The Board came out of executive session and resumed the regular meeting.
