

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a of the New York State Industrial Development Agency Act of Article 18-A of the New York State General Municipal Law, as amended, will be held by the County of Rockland Industrial Development Agency (the “Agency”) on the 30th day of April, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. local time, at Orangetown Town Hall, 26 Orangeburg Road, Orangeburg, New York 10962. The public hearing will concern the Agency’s providing additional financial assistance for a project more fully described below.

CoreWeave, Inc. (the “Applicant”) has submitted an Application for Financial Assistance dated August 6, 2024, and amended by letter dated November 1, 2024 and supplemented by an April 1, 2026 letter (described below) (the “Application”) to the County of Rockland Industrial Development Agency (the “Agency”) for financial assistance with respect to a project for the acquisition, construction, installation, renovation, refurbishment or replacement of materials, goods, supplies, hardware, software, furnishings, machinery, equipment, fixtures and other tangible personal property to be installed within approximately 80,000 square feet of space in a building located at the street address 2000 Corporate Drive, Orangeburg, New York 10962 to provide high-valued cloud computing services to its customers in the New York Metro and Tri-State Region, many of which operate in the AI space for a customer base which includes such vital industries as biotechnology, finance, technology and media and entertainment (the “Project”).

The cost of the Project had been estimated to be approximately \$600,000,000 and the Applicant anticipates that approximately 12 full time equivalent jobs will be created upon completion and stabilization of operations.

In a letter dated April 1, 2026, the Applicant has advised the Agency that the original estimated capital expenditures for the Project are now expected to exceed the \$600,000,000 original estimated cost and now anticipate spending an additional \$600,000,000 for the Project.

The Applicant has requested additional financial assistance (“Additional Financial Assistance”) from the Agency in the form of additional sales tax exemptions in the amount of not to exceed \$50,250,000 in connection with the Project. The Applicant also requests that the Agency approve CoreWeave Compute Acquisitions Co. III, LLC (“CCAC III”) as an additional project occupant and direct agent of the Agency, and that the Applicant and CCAC III serve as co-project occupants for purposes of the Project and Additional Financial Assistance.

A representative of the Agency will at the above-stated time and place to hear oral comments and accept written comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to the granting of any of the foregoing financial assistance or the location or nature of the Project.
